Decision and Reasons

S. 19 Neglect of Duty

On April 12th, 2024, the Officers were called to "disorderlies". Once on scene they spoke with employee who requested the Complainant to be removed. The Officers approached the Complainant and informed him he had to leave the premises. The Complainant became argumentative and advised that he had contacted the police as he was being harassed. The Officers requested on multiple occasions for the Complainant to leave and they would address his concerns outside the premises. The Complainant continued to refuse which left the Officers with the only option to physically remove the Complainant.

Once outside the Officers engaged with the Complainant in conversation to understand his complaint however, the Complainant was vague with details and informed that he had been harassed for 6 years starting where he lived and including that the police were harassing him as well.

The Investigator reviewed all available resources and concluded the officers acted accordingly within the law and the performance of their duties.
