The Respondent Officer determined there was no reasonable prospect of a conviction and chose not to take further action in accordance with all governing authorities contained in the Criminal Code and [REDACTED] Police Service Procedures.

The Investigator agreed with the Respondent Officer's decision that criminal charges were not warranted in this matter.
