## **Decision and Reasons**

The Complainant was lawfully arrested, searched and had his property held while he was in custody. There is no evidence to show the Complainant had any money in his possession. None of the Respondent Officers were observed to be in possession of money at any time. Video evidence shows the Complainant's wallet appeared to be empty.

The Respondent Officers monitored the Complainant's condition and contacted paramedics at the first opportunity when it was determined the Complainant required medical assistance.

The Respondent Officer used force in accordance with the Police Interactions Training Aid. The application of force was minimal and did not likely cause any injury to the Complainant. Any injury can be attributed to the Complainant struggling after he was arrested in which he aggravated a previous injury.

The Respondent Officer spoke with the Complainant, listened to his concerns, and conducted a preliminary investigation. The Respondent Officer requested the Complainant leave the police station when he became disruptive after being told his allegation of missing money was untruthful. The Respondent Officer had the lawful authority to use force to remove the Complainant from the building. The force used was minimal.
