De-identified Summary of Complaint

On October 28, 2024, [REDACTED] Police Service received a 911 call for a “shooting” at the Complainant’s apartment building.

Multiple police officers attended the apartment building and secured the area.

The Complainant encountered police officers in the stairwell of his building and was asked to leave the building.

The Complainant advised the Respondent Officer acted in an aggressive, overbearing and militaristic manner while interacting with the Complainant. Saying “I’m holding a big gun answer my questions.” It is further alleged the Respondent Officer threatened the Complainant by his demeanor and Respondent Officer searched him.

Unsubstantiated Code of Conduct Allegations

Undermine public trust

Section 10(1) A police officer shall not conduct themselves in a manner that undermines, or is likely to undermine, public trust in policing.

Decision and Reasons

During the brief interaction with the Complainant, the Respondent Officer did not yell, threatened, act aggressively, nor accost the Complainant. Nor did he search the Complainant.

Respondent Officer did not inappropriately display nor use his C8 carbine rifle in an aggressive nor militaristic manner. Respondent Officer carried the C8 carbine rifle in accordance with training.

Respondent Officer did not say "I'm holding a big gun answer my questions".

BWC clearly captured the entire interaction with Complainant.
