Decision and Reasons

The interaction between the Complainant and Respondent officer was captured on body-cam. The respondent officer was professional during the encounter and advised the Complainant that their vehicle would be returned after it was processed.

The Respondent Officer lawfully seized the vehicle pursuant to section 489 of the Criminal Code. An inventory search was conducted pursuant to policy.

A warrant was obtained to search the vehicle. Following the vehicle being processed, it was returned to the Complainant.
