The Complainant alleged that, the Respondent Officers used unnecessary force towards him after they denied him entry to  Division to use the washroom for a second time.

## Decision and Reasons

The Complainant alleged on the submitted complaint that the incident occurred on October 16th, 2024, however upon speaking with the Investigator the Complainant stated the incident occurred on October 9th, 2024.

There was a similar incident that occurred on May 8th, 2024, with the Complainant. The Complainant was given multiple opportunities to review his allegation and amend the date if necessary. However, he remained firm in asserting that he provided the correct date on which the alleged misconduct occurred.

The investigation did not identify any Respondent Officers who interacted with the Complainant on October 9th, 2024.

Therefore the allegations were unsubstantiated.
