The Complainant has alleged that the Respondent Officers failed to conduct a thorough at-scene investigation which he alleges led to him being unlawfully arrested.

Decision and Reasons

After the Complainant's initial arrest in order to ensure the safety of all involved and to prevent an offence, the RO's conducted a thorough at scene investigation once the scene was secured, which led to the unconditional release of the Complainant. All of their justified actions and subsequent explanation regarding their actions, were captured on their BWC's.

Based on the information that the RO's had at the time, (daughter's version of events and urgency of the radio call involving a knife), they formed reasonable and probable grounds that the Complainant had threatened to kill his daughter and they lawfully arrested him.
