Decision and Reasons

Allegation 1 – Neglects to do Duty-The investigation revealed that the Respondent Officers listened attentively to the Complainant and based on the information provided, determined that grounds did not exist for criminal charges to be laid. The Investigator concluded that there was insufficient evidence to establish reasonable grounds that misconduct occurred.
