Complainant in [REDACTED] alleged unlawful physical contact by the subject officer. Statement taken from complainant and an investigative report was initiated. Statement of subject officer, witness officers, and 911 recordings reviewed. Insufficient evidence to believe that misconduct occurred. Lead investigator was unable to determine exactly what occurred as there were two opposing versions of events (complainant vs. subject officer) both of which had significant overlap. Threshold for misconduct not reached and allegation was unsubstantiated as a result.
