De-identified Summary of Complaint

The complainant reported being the victim of an assault, threats, and vulgar insults by a neighbor on August 30th, 2024. Although she promptly contacted the [REDACTED] Police Service and provided a statement, she received no follow-up despite repeated attempts to contact the investigating officers.

The complainant alleged that months later, she had still not been informed of any actions taken or the outcome of the investigation. She believed the lack of response may have been linked to discrimination based on her age, gender, or French language, and she felt the police failed in their duty to protect and inform her as a victim.
