De-identified Summary of Complaint

The Complainant alleges the Respondent Officer taunted two homeless people and then used unnecessary force when he drove his bicycle over her foot.

Unsubstantiated Code of Conduct Allegations

Conduct that Undermines the Public Trust Section 10 (1)

Incivility Section 12 (1)

Unnecessary or excessive use of force Section 11(1)

Decision and Reasons

The Respondent Officer was on general bicycle patrol. The Respondent Officer denies he used the alleged uncivil language and there is no evidence to show that he did. The Witness Officer supports his denials. The homeless people were never identified.

Although the RO rode his bicycle over the Complainant's foot this cannot be considered "use of force", as the contact was unintentional and did not cause any injury to the Complainant.
