De-identified Summary of Complaint

The Complainant alleged that (Redacted) attended to assist her as she was threatened and criminally harassed by her landlord. Additionally, a friend she was with was spat on. The (Redacted) members conducted a negligent investigation, called her a liar, and failed to lay charges.

The second portion of the Complainant's allegations pertain to the (Redacted) attacking her, taking her to hospital, and treating her unfairly. The Complainant also alleges that the officers who transported her to the Hospital drove recklessly and caused minor injuries to her.

Decision and Reasons

The Complainant alleged misconduct on the part of four (Redacted) officers. The alleged misconduct occurred on two different occasions in 2024. The investigation was undertaken by a member of the (Redacted)Service's Professional Standards Branch. Addition evidence, such as GPS data of police vehicles, 911 recordings, legislation, case law/decisions was gathered. The allegations have been unsubstantiated.
