### De-identified Summary of Complaint

The Complainant (CO) alleged they met the Respondent Officer (RO) on the Facebook dating application. The CO and RO went on two dates and on the second date the CO was invited to stay over night at the RO's residence due to the quantity of alcoholic beverage they consumed. The CO alleged the RO drugged and sexually assaulted them.

On August 1, 2024, the CO reported the incident to police and no criminal charges were laid against the RO. On November 9, 2024, the CO filed a complaint with the Law Enforcement Complaint Agency as a result of the incident.

The (Redacted) investigated the incident and found the allegation to be unsubstantiated.
