De-identified Summary of Complaint

The complainant was involved in an on-going dispute with his landlord. He reported two incidents to [Redacted] Police Service, on April 4th, 2025, and April 27th, 2025, which were dismissed by police. The respondent officer, attended the complainant's home on May 4th, 2025. The complainant alleged the RO uttered "Fuck Off" to him. Moreover, the RO helped the landlord evict the complainant from his home. Lastly, the RO was disrespectful to the complainant and facilitated the removal of complainant's belongings.

Unsubstantiated Code of Conduct Allegations

10 Conduct undermines public trust

Decision and Reasons

During April 2025, and May 2025, the complainant and the landlord entered into a dispute over rent money owed by the complainant, and money owed to the complainant by the landlord for legal services provided.

On May 4th, 2025, the RO responded to the dispute between the complainant and the landlord, at the complainant's home.

The complainant clarified later in the investigation that he never heard the RO utter the words "Fuck off" to him.

The RO never engaged in any eviction process or removal of the complainant's belongings from the home. The RO ensured the complainant had the entrance door access code on May 4th 2025, and advised the complainant to secure his belongings in his room.

There is no evidence to substantiate any claims made by the complainant.
