The investigator determined that there were insufficient reasonable and probable grounds to substantiate the allegation of Using Unnecessary Force.

The complainant reported that he was arrested by police for an offence. While being arrested, the complainant stated that police used excessive force to effect the arrest.

The Professional Standards Branch Investigator reviewed all available evidence, including body worn camera recordings of the arrest.

Based on the information reviewed, the allegation has been determined to be unsubstantiated.
