On [REDACTED] the Complainant attended [REDACTED] in the [REDACTED] Ontario.

At approximately [REDACTED] the Complainant was arrested by members of the [REDACTED] Police Service [REDACTED] for failure to comply with a judicial release order.

The Complainant alleged the respondent officers conducted an unlawful arrest, used excessive force during the arrest, spoke to him in a belittling manner and lost some of his personal property, namely a cellular phone.

The Law Enforcement Complaints Agency (LECA) received a complaint of professional misconduct in relation to the events described. LECA referred this complaint to [REDACTED] to investigate.
