Sergeant Douglas Rose

The penalties in this matter imposed under section 85(1)(f) of the Police Services Act will be:

1. For unlawful or unnecessary arrest --forfeiture of five (5) days

2. For unlawful or unnecessary force --forfeiture of five (5) days

The penalties will be served concurrently.

Constable Brian Arcand

The penalties in the matter imposed under section 85(1)(d) of the Police Services Act will be:

1. For unlawful or unnecessary arrest --suspension without pay for a period of ten (10) days

2. For unlawful or unnecessary force --suspension without pay for a period of ten (10) days

The penalties will be served concurrently.

Constable Blair Liburd

The penalty in this matter imposed under section 85(1)(f) of the Police Services Act will be:

1. For discreditable conduct--forfeiture of five (5) days

Constable Jermaine Fuller

The penalty in this matter imposed under section 85(1)(e) of the Police Services Act will be:

1. For discreditable conduct--forfeiture of two (2) days
