Unlawful or Unnecessary Exercise of Authority

On May 4, 2016, Constable Andalib-Goortani submitted a written letter of apology (exhibit 7) to the complainant, and she accepted the letter. Mr. Marrocco, the appointed outside prosecutor advised the Tribunal that the Office of the Independent Review Director (OIPRD) is aware of the resolution and have no concerns with it.

Mr. Marrocco asked that the matter be marked withdrawn since all parties are agreeable to the resolution.

Based on these submissions, the Hearing Officer accepted the position of the prosecution and case 35 for 2011 was marked withdrawn.
